

	Suggested Point	Action Taken
	<p>The Chair recommended initiating a Green and Energy Audit to assess resource consumption, promote sustainability practices, and align with institutional social responsibility and SDG goals.</p>	<p>The process for conducting a Green and Energy Audit was initiated under the leadership of Dr. N. M. G. Kumar, Professor, EEE department. Registration with a certified third-party agency was completed. Preliminary data related to power, water, waste management, and infrastructure has been collected from all departments. The audit is scheduled to begin in the coming weeks. Findings will be documented in a Green Campus Report and used for sustainability planning and accreditation purposes.</p>
<p>The Chair advised departments to review laboratories in computing and core engineering disciplines to strengthen hands-on learning, innovation, and industry readiness.</p>	<p>In response to the Chair's recommendation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The institution instituted the Dr. Mohan Babu Startup Fund worth ₹2 Crores to support student idea incubation and prototyping. ● 10 advanced research laboratories were established with an investment of ₹3 Crores, focusing on interdisciplinary innovation and applied engineering research. ● CIR labs were enhanced and re-established with advanced equipment worth ₹10 Lakhs, supporting placement-oriented training and industry-specific skill development. ● Faculty members completed Innovation Ambassador Training under the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell, equipping them to mentor student-led innovation and entrepreneurship activities. ● Departments began offering consultancy services to industries in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu, reflecting growing industry-academic collaboration. 	

	<p>Faculty members were encouraged to increase their research output by publishing in high-impact journals and filing patents.</p>	<p>As a result of sustained encouragement and institutional support:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Faculty members published 1,150 research papers in reputed international journals and conferences indexed in Scopus and Web of Science during the academic year 2024-2025. • A total of 62 patents were filed and published, reflecting the institution's strong focus on innovation and intellectual property creation. • The H-index of the University reached 52 in just its third year of operation.
	<p>The Chair suggested organizing more academic events like conferences, seminars, workshops, and guest lectures to enrich knowledge exchange and promote interdisciplinary dialogue.</p>	<p>In response to the Chair's suggestion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 7 international conferences were successfully organized, with papers published in Scopus-indexed proceedings, facilitating global research collaboration and academic visibility. • A National Conference on Nurturing Agricultural Technologies for Uplifting Rural Economy (NATURE-1) was conducted, addressing interdisciplinary themes related to agriculture, sustainability, and rural development. • Several guest lecture programs were held, featuring experts from academia and industry to provide insights into current trends and emerging technologies.
	<p>It was recommended that departments integrate internships with academic projects to enhance industry exposure and practical problem-solving skills among students.</p>	<p>Departments collaborated with industry partners to facilitate internships for final-year students, which were aligned with their major project work. MoUs with new organizations were leveraged for this purpose. Students submitted interim reports and received mentorship from both faculty and industry supervisors.</p>

	<p>The chairperson briefed the members about the recent transformation of NAAC accreditation credit (A+) from Sree Vidyanikethan Engineering College to Mohan Babu University with existing validity.</p>	
<p>3</p>	<p>Review of Technical Association Activities</p>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Department Heads presented the summary of technical association events organized during the semester, including guest lectures, hands-on workshops, coding contests, hackathons, and technical symposiums. 	

4	<p>Review of Industrial Visits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reports on recent industrial visits conducted by various departments were shared. These visits provided students exposure to practical industrial processes and corporate culture. • Departments were encouraged to plan visits to emerging sectors such as AI, renewable energy, and advanced manufacturing. • Collaboration with industry partners for joint-certification programs was suggested.
5	<p>Review of Placements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Placement Cell presented a detailed report on placement activities. • Data was shared regarding the number of companies visited, sectors represented, average and highest CTC offered, and placement percentages across departments. • Emphasis was placed on resume-building workshops, aptitude training, and mock interviews. • Additional industry tie-ups and alumni involvement in placement drives were recommended.
6	<p>Review of Sports & Games</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Physical Education Department presented updates on interdepartmental and inter-college sports competitions. • Achievements of students at university/state level events were acknowledged.
7	<p>Review of NSS Activities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The NSS Unit submitted a report highlighting recent social outreach programs such as blood donation camps, tree plantation drives, awareness rallies, and cleanliness campaigns. • Future plans include organizing health check-up camps, digital literacy programs, and collaborations with local NGOs to enhance community engagement.
8	<p>Review of Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey(SSS)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The IQAC director presented a comprehensive analysis of The Student Satisfaction Survey results. • Plan to organize Faculty Development Programs based on feedback survey.

The meeting was concluded by the IQAC Director, who expressed gratitude to all attendees for their engaged involvement, insightful counsel, and assistance.
