The required data and supporting documents related to NIRF ranking and accreditation parameters were compiled, verified, and submitted in February 2026. The report highlighted institutional preparedness in teaching-learning, research, innovation, outreach, and SDG initiatives. Continuous monitoring and documentation processes were carried out to strengthen compliance, and the institution is currently awaiting the results from the concerned agencies.</p>
	<p>The Chair advised the Academic and Technology Integration Coordinator to prepare and present a comprehensive report on the adoption of the latest tools and technologies, including digital learning initiatives, certification programs, technology-enabled teaching practices, and skill development activities for the academic year 2025–2026.</p>	<p>As advised by the Chair, the Academic and Technology Integration Coordinator presented a comprehensive report on the adoption of the latest tools and technologies for the academic year 2025–2026. It was reported that approximately 6,800 students completed over 1 lakh certifications through various MOOC platforms, with courses aligned to industry and workforce requirements. The report also highlighted the effective integration of digital learning tools, technology-</p>

		<p>enabled teaching practices, and competency-based education across departments, contributing to enhanced skill development, employability, and professional competency among students.</p>
	<p>The Chair advised the Research and Innovation Coordinators to prepare and present a comprehensive report on research paper publications, patents, funded projects, and consultancy activities, including details of research output, innovation contributions, funding support, and project outcomes, for the academic year 2025-202.</p>	<p>In continuation of the Chair's advice, the Dean R&I presented a comprehensive report on research paper publications, patents, funded projects, and consultancy activities for the academic year 2025-2026. Key highlights include the publication of 1,058 research papers by faculty and researchers of MBU in peer-reviewed journals and conferences indexed in Scopus, with several also indexed in Web of Science. The report also highlighted the publication of 154 patents during the AY 2025-2026, demonstrating strong innovation and research output. In addition, one government-funded research project worth ₹12.6 lakhs is currently in progress, and faculty members successfully executed nine consultancy projects worth ₹146.69 lakhs, strengthening industry-academia collaboration and applied research initiatives. The compiled report reflects significant progress in research productivity, innovation, funded research, and consultancy activities, and was submitted for review.</p>

The initiatives strengthened industry-academia collaboration, enhanced employability, and supported experiential learning across departments.</p>

For the academic year 2025–2026, it was reported that these programs significantly contributed to improving students' language proficiency, communication competence, and employability skills, thereby enhancing their readiness for higher education and global career opportunities.</p>

<p>A comprehensive review on industrial visits was carried out, with detailed analysis of student participation, industry exposure, and learning</p>	

outcomes. For the academic year 2025–2026, it was reported that students from various departments actively participated in industrial visits to reputed industries and organizations, gaining practical insights into industrial processes, emerging technologies, and professional practices, thereby strengthening experiential learning and industry-academia interaction.

Review on NSS Activities, Sports and Games

A comprehensive review on NSS activities, Sports, and Games was carried out, with detailed analysis of student participation, achievements, and institutional performance in various competitions. For the academic year 2025–2026, students actively participated in national and inter-collegiate sports events, winning medals in athletics, cricket, basketball, Kabaddi, and Throwball, bringing laurels to the institution. It was also reported that students secured 1st Prize in the National SCoPSYutoria Kabaddi Competition and achieved Runner-up position in Basketball at VignanMahotsav, reflecting excellence in sports and extracurricular activities.

- k. Preparation and submission of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).
